ABOUT CHURCH ON BAYSHORE

The mission of Church on Bayshore is to do whatever it takes to see people Believe in Jesus, Belong to God's Family, and to Become who God created us to be, impacting the world for Christ. Founded in 1910, Church on Bayshore (First Baptist Church of Niceville) has a long legacy of making a kingdom impact in this community and the nations.

In the past 5 years, overall attendance at Church on Bayshore has grown by 52.2% and currently averages over 1,000 on Sunday mornings. This growth is seen in every age group, but is largely in younger families with children and students, with 111.7% growth in kids and 57.1% growth in middle and high school students. There are currently 90-100 students engaged regularly in student ministry.

ABOUT NICEVILLE

Niceville is located on the Choctawhatchee Bay, directly across from the white-sand beaches of Destin. Within a 5-mile radius, the estimated population is 36,000 and the population is projected to continue to grow. Niceville is near several large military bases: Eglin Air Force Base, Hurlburt Field, Duke Field, and the Army's 7th Special Forces. Many of the area's residents are connected to the military or work on base.

Area schools consistently perform at the top level in the state of Florida. Middle & High Schools in Niceville: Niceville High School, Collegiate High School at Northwest Florida State College, Ruckel and Lewis Middle Schools, STEM Academy and Rocky Bayou Christian School (K-12).

Though the majority of Church on Bayshore's families are in the Niceville/Valparaiso area, there are also members from Destin, Freeport, Crestview, and Fort Walton Beach/Shalimar.

While Niceville is situated in an area of the United States referred to as the Bible Belt, the reality is that less than 1/3 of the community is connected to and involved in a local church, so there is a huge mission field. Church on Bayshore is committed to reaching our local community and the nations with the gospel.

ABOUT THE STUDENT MINISTER

The Student Minister at Church on Bayshore is charged with leading students to Believe in Jesus, Belong to God's family, and Become who God created them to be. The student minister should possess both a desire to help students love Jesus with all of their heart, to disciple them in the Word, and to reach the unreached students and families in our community.

The Student Minister's primary responsibilities:

- Provide vision and direction for Bayshore Students in alignment with the vision of Church on Bayshore
- Provide direction and teaching for High School Ministry and Middle School Ministry
- Equip, disciple, and shepherd students
- Recruit and train Student Ministry volunteers for Student LIFEGroups, Student Worship, and Events
- Partner with parents through communication and resources
- Collaborate and work with Staff and Lay Ministry Teams
