Medications (if applicable)

TIME AWAY FORMS

While we highly discourage students from missing any part of the weekend, we understand participants may have other commitments. For students to leave DNOW they must submit a completed "Time Away Form" in advance. This form is for any student that needs to leave at any time during the weekend. You will not be allowed to leave at any time if we do not have a time away form on file.

What is the cost for DNOW?

The cost is \$80 per student (covers transportation, lodging, meals other than breakfast, recreation & a DNOW T-Shirt).

Is confidential financial assistance available?

Yes, partial scholarships are available and based on need. All scholarships are confidential. Please contact teria@churchonbayshore.org if you need assistance or have further questions.

How will groups be formed?

Students will request to be placed with their friends for the weekend. Our team will work to honor requests and place students based on many factors including their schools and Life Groups. If you have a special request, you will need to make our team aware by contacting teria@churchonbayshore.org.

Where will my student stay for the weekend? Are these homes safe?

Students will be staying in the home of a qualified and trusted adult who is a member at Church on Bayshore. All students will be together in a shared space and sleep in sleeping bags or air mattresses. Families that are hosting for the weekend are interviewed and go through extensive training to ensure the safety of your child for the weekend. You will be given the name, address and contact information for your students host home.

Who will be leading my student through Bible Study?

Bible Studies will be taught by college-aged leaders. Each college-aged leader is interviewed and submits an application. Once they are approved, they must follow our policy guidelines and spend time training at Bayshore leading into the weekend.

Will my student be allowed to drive?

Students will be allowed to drive to their host home on Friday night and Sunday morning to the final worship service. Otherwise, students WILL NOT be allowed to drive during the weekend. Only adult leaders and approved drivers can drive students.

What if my student has food and/or pet allergies?

Please indicate this on the student's registration. We will not place your student in a host home that cannot accommodate their allergy requests. If your student has a food allergy, please be sure to bring snacks that they can enjoy!

What if my student has medicine that needs to be taken during the weekend?

There is a Check-In station on Friday night. You can fill out a form upon arrival & drop off needed medications at that time.

Will cell phones or technology be allowed?

Students can bring their cell phone for emergency purposes only. The phones should be off and not in use for the weekend.

My student wants to bring a friend. Is that ok?

YES! Please encourage your student to bring their friends. We will ensure that they are placed in your student's group and home for the entire weekend!
